What:

EYE (pronounced E-Y-E) stands for Episcopal Youth Event. It is a tri-annual gathering of youth from around the world, assembled on a college campus to learn, laugh, and worship together. **It is the single greatest and second largest event the Episcopal Church does.** Time is spent in amazing, awesome, and authentic worship, large group presentations from entertaining, educated, engaging folks, small group discussions, workshops, and hanging out and meeting Episcopalians from around the world.

Who:

EYE has amazing preachers, speakers, and workshop leaders, but the one thing that really makes it so special is the young people who attend. **Youth will get to know people who share their Episcopal faith in all of its diversity, and come away from EYE with more than memories,** although those will last a lifetime. Through new friends and the gathered community, youth will gain a greater understanding of their personal connection to something much bigger.

Where:

EYE23 will be held at the beautiful University of Maryland in the Washington, DC metro area. The closest airport is National (DCA). Baltimore (BWI) and Dulles (IAD) are also nearby. Plan to arrive during the day on July 4 (Watch fireworks from UMD's quad!), and to depart by 10am on July 8. Meals are included on July 5, 6, and 7.

How:

Youth participate as part of a delegation, arranged on a diocesan level, or through another Episcopal entity/organization, like a congregation or school. Each delegation must bring at least two chaperones. **Youth must be between the ages of 15 and 19 on July 4, 2023.** Covid vaccination is required. Delegation registration will be open from January 6-March 17, 2023, or until dorm capacity is reached.
